Merriam, Kansas, located near Kansas City, has been hosting their Code of Ordinances with enCodePlus since 2020. As a city that prides itself on its small-town charm, staff appreciate having the Code of Ordinances conveniently accessible online for their planners and citizens, along with documents such as the fee schedule and several permit applications, which they keep in their enCodePlus Document Library and have available to download through the portal's main menu.

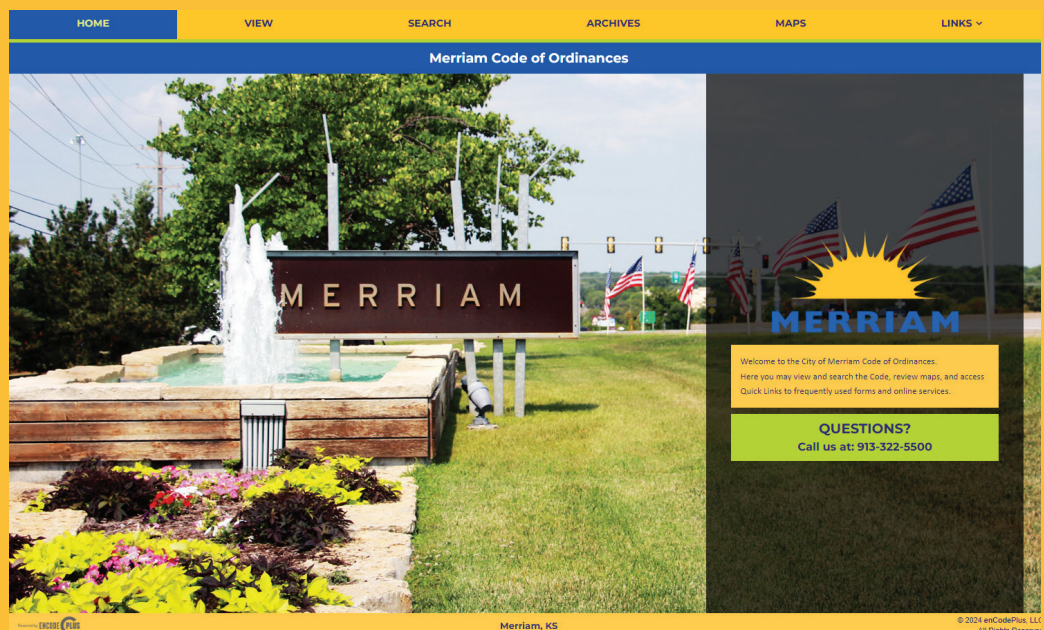
